As physiotherapist we are constantly keeping up to date in order to meet the requirements of the Health Care Professional Council (HCPC) and meet the standards set by the Chartered Society of Physiotherapy (CSP). These standards are displayed in the clinic.

Services

Ruth Cooil Physiotherapy offers a wide range of services predominantly treating musculoskeletal and sports injuries in the clinic, at sports venues or in your own home. In addition, we offer bespoke wellbeing days for businesses and pop up physiotherapy clinics. Sporting event cover is something that we excel in either on or off Island.

Appointments

Appointments can be provided in the clinic, in your own home or in your sporting environment. We aim to return all calls, emails and messages withing 24Hrs and offer an appointment within 2 weeks. At your first appointment you will asked to sign a document which covers GDPR and consent to treatment.

Payment

Payment is by cash, cheque or bank transfer. Payment is required within 24Hrs of receiving treatment. Cancellations within 24Hrs of your appointment will be charged.
